


Pixie 2- Create a Movie Presentation from Student Work

<u>Preparation</u>: Helpful Tip: Create a folder on the Student Drive (in your teacher folder) and have <u>ALL</u> students save their picture to this one folder.

Click on the <u>blue arrow</u> to hear the music. Click on the <u>green arrow</u> to add the music to your movie.

You can also click on the file folder to bring in music you have already saved.

Important Note 1:

Make sure the first slide is selected when you add music so the music starts on your first slide.

Important Note 2:

Turn the Volume on the music fairly low so you will still be able to hear student recordings if there are any. Otherwise you won't be able to hear what the students are saying.

When you are finished, click on Go Back.




