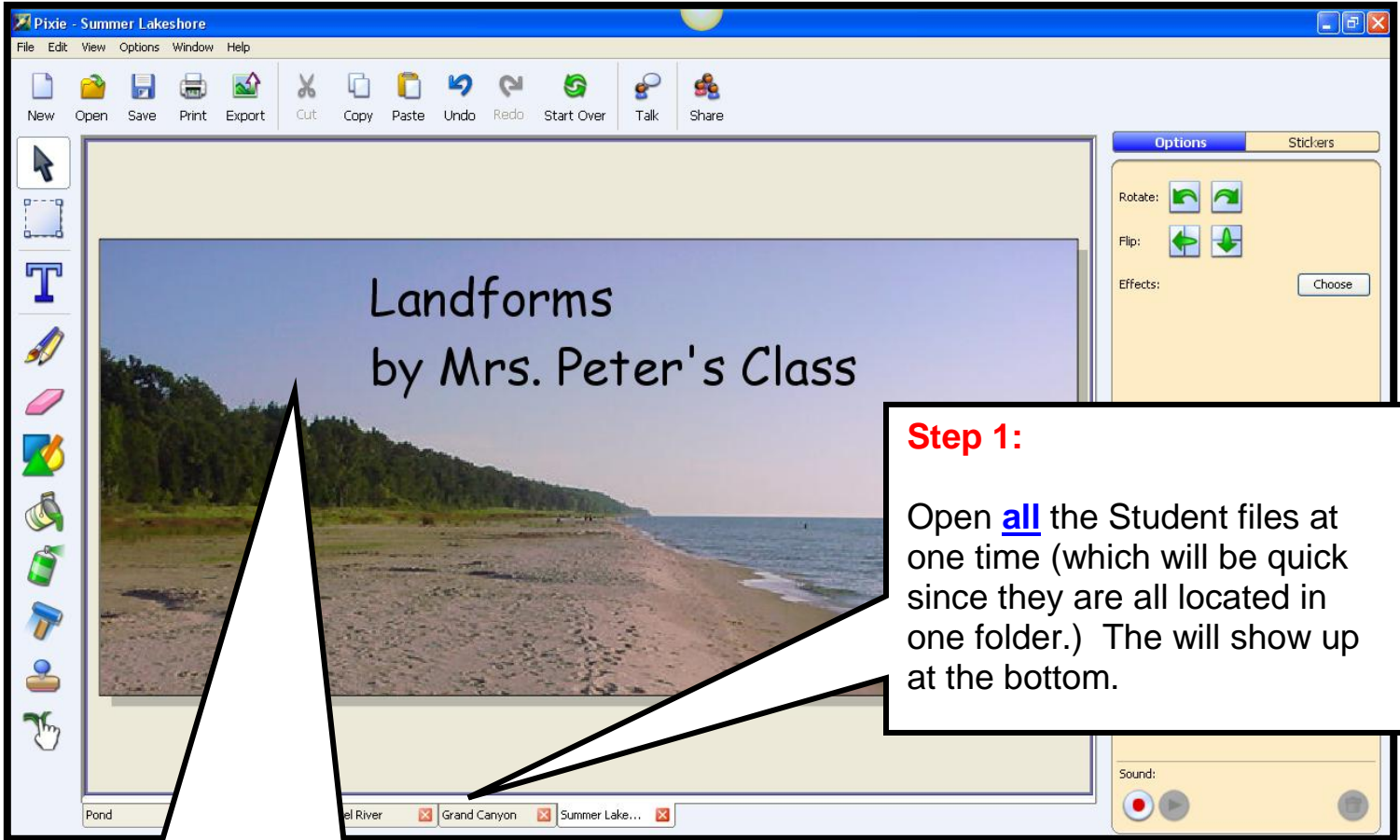


Pixie 2- Create a Movie Presentation from Student Work

Preparation: **Helpful Tip:** Create a folder on the Student Drive (in your teacher folder) and have **ALL** students save their picture to this one folder.



Step 1:

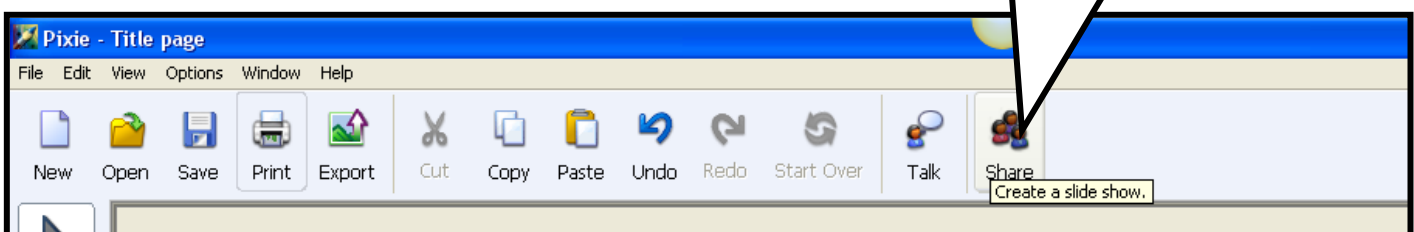
Open **all** the Student files at one time (which will be quick since they are all located in one folder.) They will show up at the bottom.

Step 2:

Click on **New** at the top.

Create a Title Page like the one you see.

Step 3: Click on **Share**.



Step 4: Drag the Title page to the front of the other pictures so that it's first.

Step 5: Click on Video.

Options: Share (Show, Video, Web), Timing: 3 seconds, Transition: [Grid, Blue, Green, Red] Edit, Background Sound: None Edit, Create

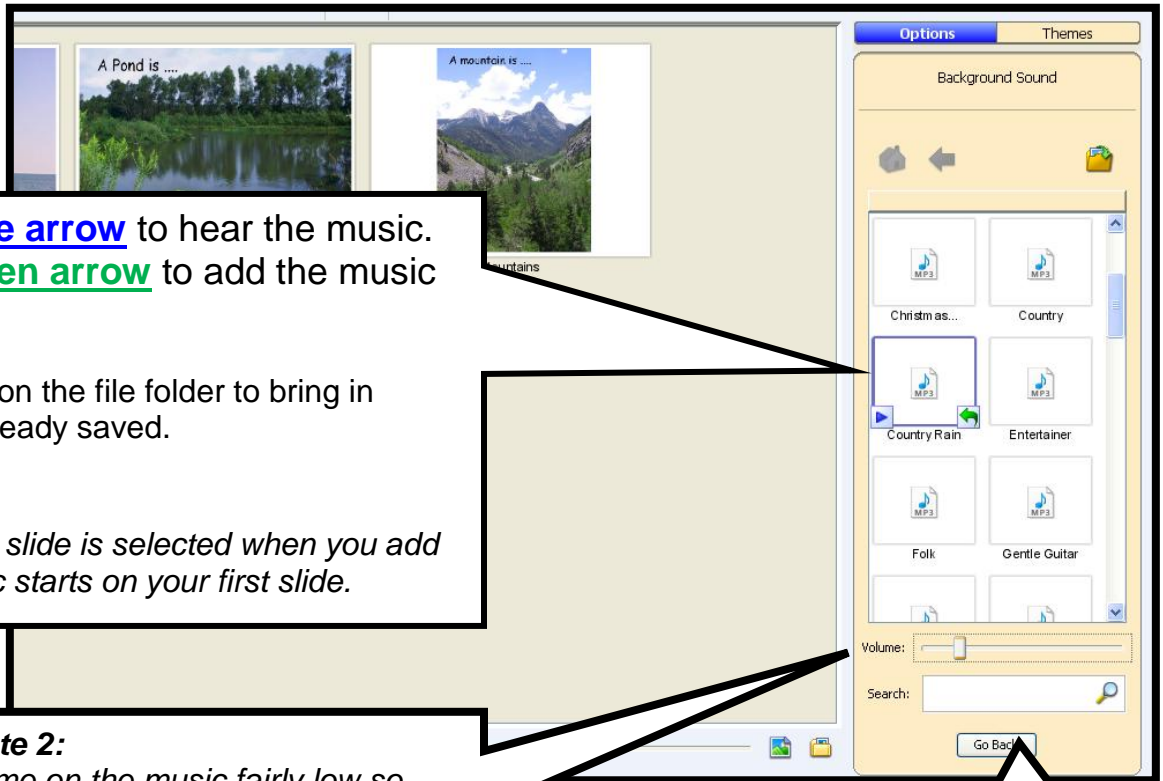
Step 6: Set the Timing.

Note: If students recorded narration, then the slide will wait until they are through reading to go to the next slide.

Step 7: Change Slide Transitions if you like.

Step 8: Add background Music (optional)
-Check Background Sound
Click Edit

Options: Share (Show, Video), Timing: 3 seconds, Transition: [Grid, Blue, Green, Red], Background Sound: None Edit, Create



Click on the **blue arrow** to hear the music.
Click on the **green arrow** to add the music to your movie.

You can also click on the file folder to bring in music you have already saved.

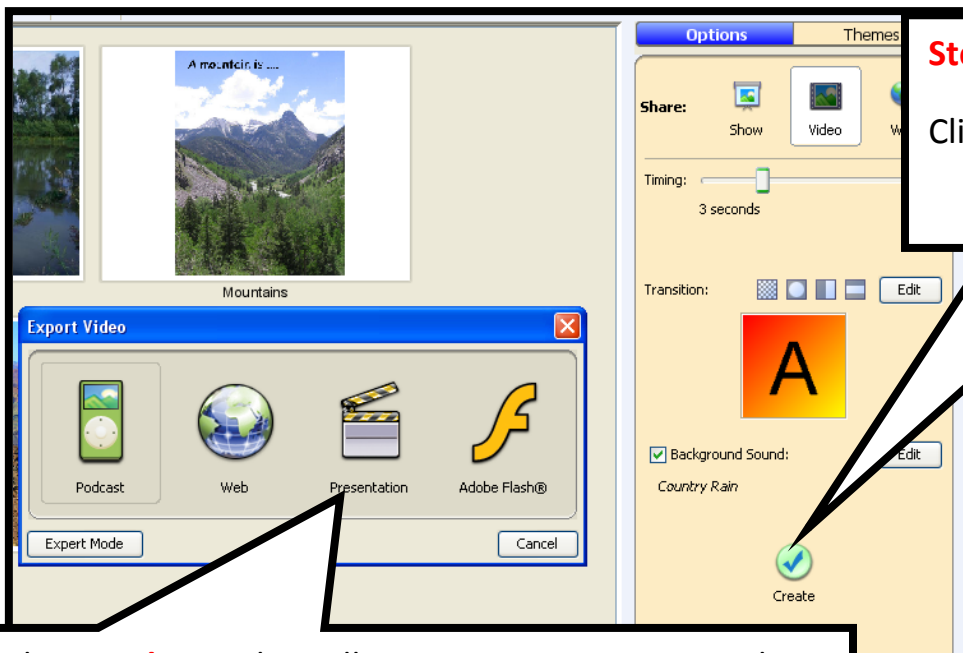
Important Note 1:

Make sure the first slide is selected when you add music so the music starts on your first slide.

Important Note 2:

Turn the Volume on the music fairly low so you will still be able to hear student recordings if there are any. Otherwise you won't be able to hear what the students are saying.

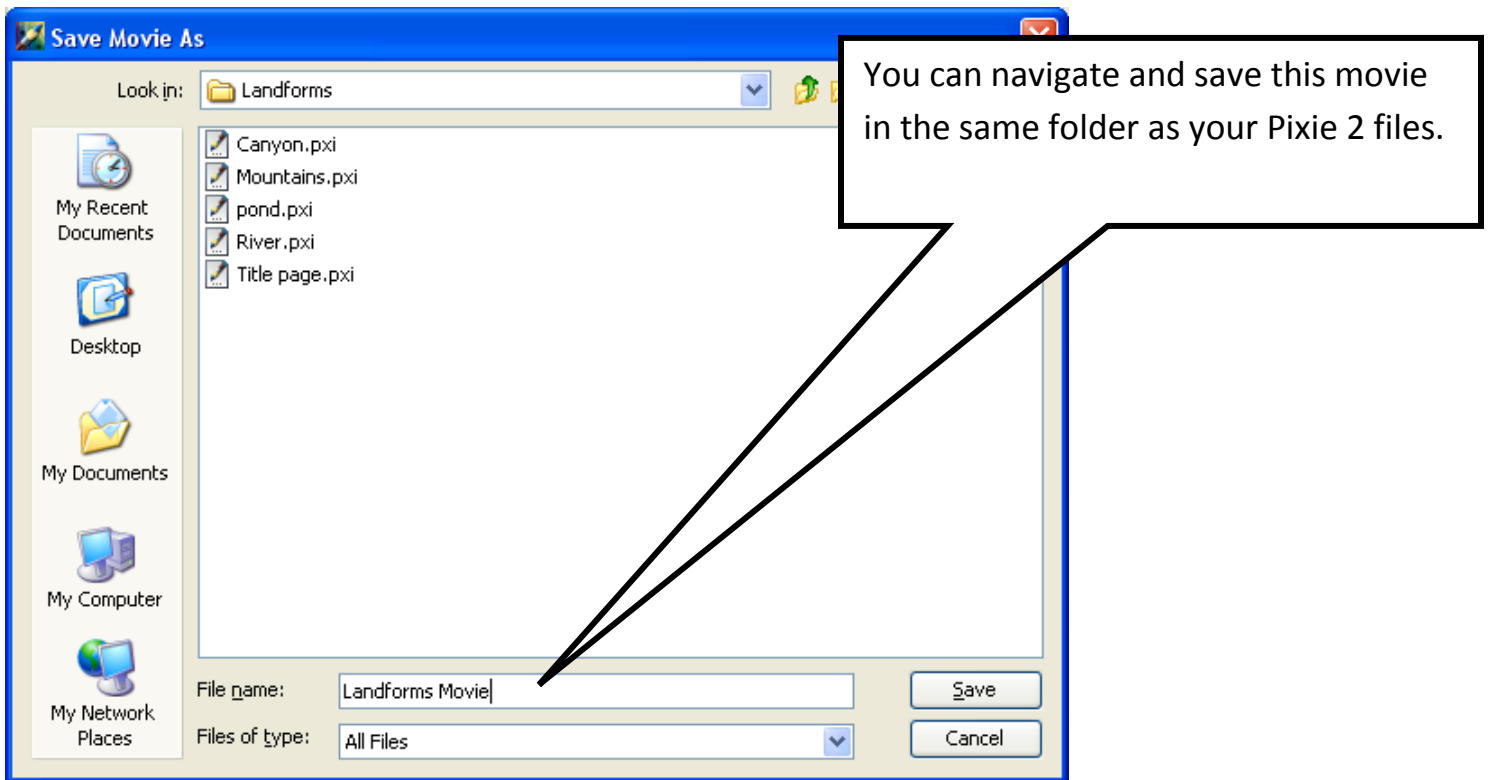
When you are finished, click on **Go Back**.



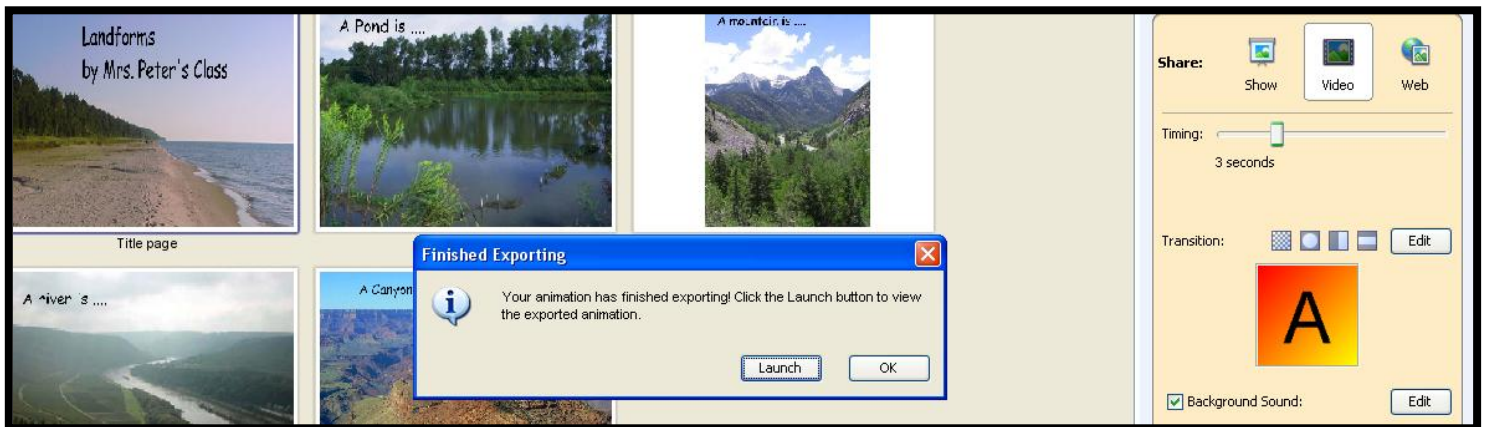
Step 9: Create your Movie

Click on the **Create** button

Click on **Podcast**- This will save your movie so it can be uploaded as a podcast to a podcast publishing site such as <http://www.podbean.com>



When it is finished creating your movie, you can click Launch to watch it in Quicktime.



From now on, you can open this file directly without being in Pixie 2 and it will open in Quicktime.

- You can loop your movie once it opens in Quick Time viewer.
- Click on View>Loop
- View in full screen also. Click on View>Full Screen (this is free now)
- You can also upload this to <http://www.podbean.com> and get a code to embed this on your blog, wiki or web page.
